



3 On 3 Tournament

Regulations

1. Games are 20 minutes running time
2. Scoring: **3** points for a 3 pointer, **2** points for a regular basket.
3. Fouls:
 - a. Shooting Fouls:
 - i. If they miss they get **1** point and the ball back.
 - ii. If they make the shot, count the basket plus **1** point and they **do not** get the ball.
 - b. Non shooting fouls:
 - i. More than **3 minutes** are left in the game, they take the ball at the top.
 - ii. **Within the last 3 minutes of the game**, they shoot **1** free throw and get the ball at the top.
This eliminates intentional fouls.
4. The ball **MUST** be cleared past the 3-point line and in between the hash marks.
5. The 3-second rule is enforced for 5th graders and above. The refs will be verbal and let you know to get out of the lane before calling it.
6. No timeouts are going to be given.
7. Once a defensive team has gained possession of the ball they must be allowed to dribble the ball past the three-point line between the hash marks without defensive pressure on the ball. The other players may be guarded.
8. When possession has changed the ball must be cleared past the three-point line between the hash marks.
 - a. i.e. Team B steals a pass after a rebound before its cleared past the 3 point line, Team B needs to clear the ball past the 3 point line between the hash marks because of the change of possession on the rebound.
9. A jump ball will be awarded to a team by alternating possession.
10. Substitutions can be made on any dead ball.
11. Overtime:
 - a. In case of a tie a 1:00 minute overtime will take place.
 - b. If still tied after 1:00 minute then it becomes sudden death.

Things to Know

- No Outside Food - Concessions are available all day.
- Admission \$5.00 per adult, \$3.00 per student
 - 5 years and under free
 - 55 and older free
- Doors Open at 7:30 am
 - To get to the Elementary Gym enter through door AE (parking is available behind the main entrance near the football/softball fields).
 - To get to the MS Gym enter through Door O
 - To get to the HS Gym, you can either enter through Door O, or through Door H (additional parking is available on this side of the building near the baseball field)
- Captains are responsible for notifying their teams of their playing times, in which gym they play, explaining the rules to their teams, and reporting the scores of the finished games to the registration table. There will be an official's table to handle all questions and conflicts at each gym.
- To start the game, either flip a coin or use paper-rock-scissors.
- Courts are numbered from 1-8. Know which one you play on. Courts 1-4 in the HS gym, Courts 5 & 6 in the MS gym, and Courts 7 & 8 in the Elementary gym.
- Awards will be awarded to the top team in each division.
- Playoff brackets will be posted ASAP. Playoffs will start shortly after pool play concludes.
- If we have a problem with a team "cheap-shotting" other teams, they will be asked to leave without a refund. This is meant to be a fun and enjoyable tournament for everybody!

Ties

Pool Seeds for Playoffs will be determined in the following manner:

1st- Winning Percentage

2nd- Head to Head Competition

3rd- Total point differential in all games played

4th- Flip a coin

* Please note that if three teams are tied, the top seed is determined by point differential and then of the two teams remaining, the highest seed will go to the winner of the head to head competition
